#### APRIL

Aubrieta, Ornamental Garlic (end of the month), Azaleas (end of the month), Flowering Cherry Trees, Spring Clematis (end of the month), Laburnum, Fritillaries, Wallflowers (2nd half of the month), Hyacinths, Annual Honesty, Forget-me-nots, Narcissi, Daisies, Woad (2nd half of the month), Pansies and *Viola cornuta*, Apple blossom trees (2nd half of the month), Primroses, Campions (2nd half of the month), Tamarisks (end of the month), Tulips

#### MAY

Alchemilla, Columbine, Ornamental Garlic, Azaleas, Spring Clematis, Foxgloves, Geranium (*Pélargoniums*) (2nd half of the month), Wallflowers (2nd half of the month), Wisteria, Irises ( at their best 3<sup>rd</sup> week of the month), Dame's Rocket, Forget-me-nots, Sweet William, Woad (1<sup>st</sup> half of the month), Oriental Poppies, Pansies and *Viola cornuta*, Meadowrue, Peonies, Rhododendrons, Campions, Tamarisks (beginning of the month), Tulips (1<sup>st</sup> half of the month)

#### JUNE

Agapanthus, Alchemilla, Amaranths, Colombines, Anthemis, Ornamental Garlic, Bugloss, Nasturtiums (beginning), Clematis, Cleomes, Foxgloves, Fuchsias, Geraniums (*Pélargoniums*), Ox-eye Daisies (*Leucanthèmes*), Daylilies, Impatiens, Lavender, Lilies, Water lilies, Sweet William, Oriental Poppies, Pansies and *Viola cornuta*, Phlox, Meadowrue, Roses, Tobacco Flowers

#### JULY

Agapanthus, Ageratum, Alchemilla, Anthemis, Amaranths, Nasturtiums, Harvest Chrysanthemum, Summer Clematis, Cleomes, Coreopsis, Cosmos, Dahlias, Fuchsias, Geraniums (*Pélargoniums*), Gladioli, Heliotropes, Daylilies, Impatiens, Lavender, Lilies, Snapdragons, Water lilies, Carnations (*Dianthus*, annual and perennial), Oriental Poppies, Larkspurs, Phlox, Meadowrue, Roses, Hollyhocks, Rudbeckias, Tobacco Flowers

#### AUGUST

Agapanthus, Ageratum, Amaranths, Anthemis, Nasturtiums, Harvest Chrysanthemum, Summer Clematis, Cleomes, Coreopsis, Cosmos, Dahlias, Fuchsias, Geraniums (*Pélargoniums*), Gladioli, Heliotropes, Impatiens, Lavender, Snapdragons, Water lilies, Carnations (*Dianthus*, annual and perennial), Phlox, Larkspurs, Meadowrue, Roses, Hollyhocks, Rudbeckias, Tobacco Flowers, Tithonias, Verbenas, Zinnias

#### SEPTEMBER

Ageratum, Amaranths, Anthemis, Asters, Nasturtiums, Chrysanthemum, Summer Clematis, Cleomes, Meadow Saffron (2nd half of the month), Cosmos, Autumn Crocus, Dahlias, Fuchsias, Geraniums (*Pélargoniums*), Abyssian Gladioli, Heliotropes, Hibiscus, Impatiens, Lavender, Snapdragons, Water



lilies, Carnations (*Dianthus*, annual and perennial), Phlox, Roses, Hollyhocks, Rudbeckias, Sages, Tobacco Flowers, Tithonias, Sunflowers, Verbenas, Zinnias

#### **OCTOBER**

Amaranths, Anthemis, Asters, Nasturtiums, Chrysanthemus, Summer Clematis, Colchicum, Cosmos, Dahlias, Geraniums (*Pélargoniums*), Heliotropes, Impatiens, Lavender, Snapdragons, Carnations (*Dianthus*), Phlox, Roses, Hollyhocks, Rudbeckias, Sages, Tobacco Flowers (some species), Tithonias, Sunflowers, Verbenas
